AIR - ARTIST IN RESIDENCE Niederösterreich, June-July 2023

How was the residency?

The residency was wonderful. I would warmly recommend it to any artist looking for the right time & space frame to develop a project in great working conditions.

The minimalism style of the studio spaces is perfect to also get quality headspace and feel inspired to work. Being all residents on the same floor also made it easier to get to know each other and have a living in community feeling while having the comfort of a real personal space fully furnished.

Living in Krems and so close to the majestic Danube and beautiful Wachau villages and vineyards was a dreamy environment that provided me great inspiration. I appreciated a lot having access to the bikes to explore the surroundings and take a step back from work in the nature. I was also very glad to discover the austrian way of life and the people I met in Krems were really welcoming and especially curious about the art projects produced in the residency framework.

Having AIR & ORTE support to stay in Krems during two months allowed me to develop in situ practices -an extended field study and a collaborative tour- that I could hardly have time to experiment elsewhere. Having a background mainly in architecture offices, the residency frame gave me space to question in a much broader way what roles could architects take on the field.

Investigating alone during two intensive months the issue of "Leerstand" (vacancy) was challenging in many ways but I appreciated a lot the trust of AIR & ORTE team and the great freedom they allowed in the formulation, elaboration and restitution form of the project. I'm also deeply thankful for the unconditional support of Heidrun Schlögl -head of ORTE- who gave me great insights, local contacts and encouragements any time needed.

List of all projects, workshops, concerts, exhibitions, events etc. that you realized or participated in during your residency

Projects and events realized:

- June July 2023 / a two months field study around the "Leerstand" (vacancy) issue. I spent these two months investigating around Leerstand in groundfloors and showcases in Krems with also some NÖ and viennese inputs. Strolling, documenting, meeting many local actors and gathering datas to map and try to convey the complexity of the subject were my main activities. I tried to gather the many different stakes and parameters locally involved in the vacancy issue to bring an informed discussion around this sensible topic that cross many disciplines and expertises.
- 22.07.23 / a collaborative tour around the Landstrasse adressing the topic of "Leerstand" in ground floors and showcases. All participants were given a folding map with the itinerary and a summary of all issues that will be discussed site specificly.
 The tour was held in German and English and everyone took actively part in the discussions. The group was very heterogeneous, from children to senior people and both international residents artists and local people (Kremser, NÖ and Wiener) participated and made the exchanges very rich. After discussing the different topics on site we occupied -with prior authorization- an empty shop on the Landrasse to continue the lively exchanges with wine coming from a local restaurant.

- **05.10.23 / upcoming solo exhibition** in the Walter Zschokke library and pocket gallery. The opening will start with a discussion around the "Leerstand" topic to adress the issue with local actors in a constructive and prospective way.
